

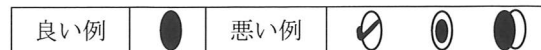




I 次の英文は、カンボジアの野生動物を守る活動について述べたものです。この英文を読み、あとの設問に答えなさい。

Dara is a beautiful tiger that loves just lying around relaxing. She also likes to be touched and talked to. Like many other animals, she really loves to play as well. Unfortunately, Dara and the other animals that live with her at the Phnom Tamao Rescue Center (P.T.R.C.), are all victims of the illegal poaching of wild animals in Cambodia. This center is a stopping point for animals that people have saved from poachers.

Many of the animals at the Rescue Center were brought there by a special team. The team is called the 'Wilderness Protection Mobile Unit,' or the 'M. U.' for short. The job of the M.U. is to drive around the country of Cambodia and rescue animals from poachers. With the support of the leaders of Cambodia, they are working very hard to stop poaching there.

In many cases, these rescued animals can be returned to the wild quickly. But in other cases, the animals need more time or special care. That is when P.T.R.C. becomes involved.

For example, there is a little \*gibbon at the center that was forced to live in a bird cage at a gas station for two years. She is now living at Phnom Tamao and the team is caring for her. The gibbon was always kept by people. It might be hard for her to go back into the wilderness. She might not know how to care for herself. She will likely be much safer, and happier at the Rescue Center.
